Why Health & Sex Education? - Health & Sex Education is an essential part of a child's education. It teaches personal and social skills as well as imparting biological knowledge of the body's functions and how it should be kept healthy and well cared for.

An appropriate and responsible health and sex education programme is an important element in the work of schools in preparing pupils for adult life.

Our Approach - Health and Sex Education in the School will be taught to give pupils an understanding of the moral considerations and the value of family life which are seen as an essential aspect of such instruction. The aim is for basis of knowledge rather than ignorance.

Parents Rights - There is no statutory right for parents to withdraw their children from health and sex education provision. The Governing Body will, however, exercise its discretion to accept or reject written requests from parents for their children to be withdrawn.
