



## Religion

Children are given experiences which help them to feel confident and be able to form relationships, demonstrate care, respect and affection for others, concentrate for lengthening periods and acquire basic life skills such as dressing themselves

**At KS1 and KS2**, pupils are given opportunities to explore how Christians and members of other religions express their faith through worship, celebration and daily life. They are taught how sacred books and important religious figures from the past and present are important sources of authority, and become familiar with key stories and events from Christianity and other faiths. Pupils are given opportunities to develop an awareness of themselves, their relationships with others and the natural world around them. They are encouraged to develop a positive and questioning approach to religious responses. They are taught to respect the beliefs of others and to express their own opinions and feelings with sensitivity and imagination.
