Sarah Lee is back with us every Thursday after a period away. I know she has checked in with several parents, but if you have any concerns or would like to speak to her, then contact the office.

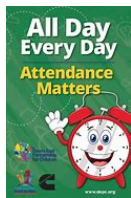
Sports day is nearly upon us. The plan is to try for the 22nd June and if we can't do this then we will try the 23rd.
